Me and My School Evaluation survey collection update

The survey window for 2009 is now closed and all data collected is now being analysed. In total we collected over **45000** pupil surveys, which is over twice the **20104** collected in 2008.

The next steps...

LA Feedback

The Research Team will produce feedback for each Local Authorities based on surveys completed during the autumn term after February Half term 2010. This feedback will not provide information on individual schools in order to maintain the confidentiality of schools involved. The feedback will be aggregated to the local authority-level and will also allow local authorities to compare their schools collectively to the national picture.

School Feedback

Schools will also receive feedback based on data collected during the autumn term which will be made available after the February 2010 half term. The feedback will be aggregated to a school-level to maintain confidentiality of each individual pupil's scores. They will receive information on the aggregated local authority picture and the national picture.

Next period of data collection

The next survey period will take place in the autumn term 2010 and will focus on year 6 and year 9 in phase one areas and year 5 and year 8 pupils in in participating phase two and three areas. Schools and local authorities will be informed of exact dates and deadlines nearer the time.

Case Studies

As part of these projects, members of the Me and My School Research team will be conducting a qualitative explanatory study, which involves members of the team visiting a small number of primary and secondary schools to talk to school staff, parents and children. This will provide a better understanding of how schools help children and general perceptions of the Targeted Mental Health in Schools (TaMHS) Project.
