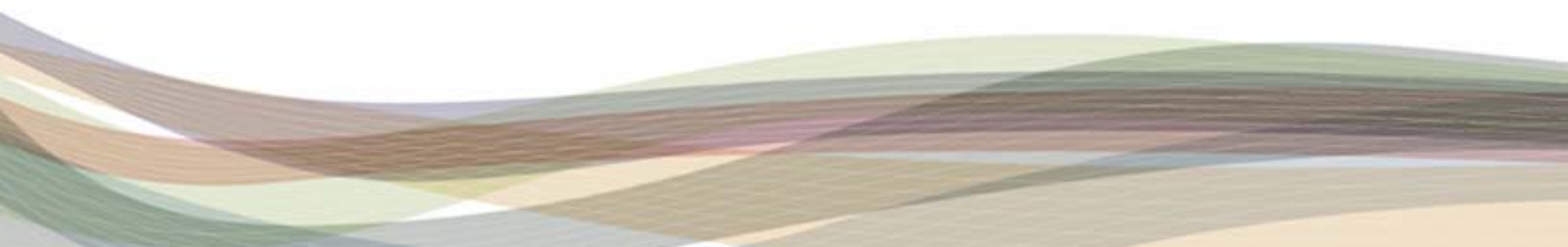


national priorities?

- Early Intervention
- Assertive Outreach
- Home Treatment
- Access to Psychological Therapies
- Supervised Community Treatment
- Community Development Workers

Community teams

- community MH teams are:
 - early intervention services
 - assertive outreach
 - home treatment
- what is already available
- the process

What will be available?

- 16+1 ethnic data categories
 - AO - No. of teams & snapshot of ethnic breakdown
 - EIP - No. of services, No. new cases & snapshot of ethnic breakdown
 - CR - No. assessments, No. patients receiving treatment, No. HT episodes & ethnic breakdown in period
 - PCT, SHA & national level
 - One off collection quarter 4
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Psychological Therapies

- access & outcome
- 2 routes for information gathering
- HCC community MH survey
 - self reported experience
 - reporting on ethnic differences
 - talking therapy & much more
 - initially 2008, previous 3 years to follow

IAPT

- LSE evaluation of pilot sites in Doncaster & Newham
- Newham 48% of referrals from BME communities
- will provide analysis on:
 - referrals, range of disorders, duration & outcome

Newham recovery

- White = 50.5%
- Asian = 66.7%
- Black = 54.2%
- Other = 50.0%
- Recovery rates did not vary significantly by ethnic group.

IAPT

- disappointing reporting on ethnicity 12 pathfinder sites
- commissioning IAPT for the whole community
- BME special interest group have developed BPG
- Work to be carried out centrally includes
 - voluntary sample from IAPT sites
 - annual audit
 - data quality checks

Supervised Community Treatment

- new act implemented from 3rd Nov, initial uptake is likely to be small
- data will become available from Q4 reporting May, analysis by ethnicity, age & gender
 - - No. on SCT, recalls, revocation & discharges
- caveat - need to understand what is happening in the general population
- long-term research commissioned by DH

Community Development Workers

- have been collecting data on CDW for some time
- schedule agreed for SHA's to report final numbers of workers
- deadline end March to confirm if national target have been met
- importantly research ongoing into how the role has been implemented

Mental Health Minimum Dataset

- nationally defined framework of data for NHS specialist MH adult & older people services (from 2003)
- activity data referring to a spell of care
- latest version included new MHL, settle accommodation & employment indicators
- all providers required to submit ethnicity data. In the past patchy but data quality is improving
